



Bachelor Of Education

B.Ed. is known as Bachelor of Education. Earlier it was known as Bachelor of Training (BT). It is a course offered for those who are interested in pursuing career in teaching and related fields. While students from Arts Stream are trained to teach subjects like History, Civics, Geography and Languages. The students from science Stream are trained to teach Mathematics, Physics, chemistry and biology. The B. Ed. degree course is mandatory for teaching in primary schools and higher secondary schools. National Council for Teacher Education is statutory body which regulates courses in teaching in India. The B.Ed. degree is mandatory for teaching in primary schools and higher secondary schools.

The main aim of B.Ed course is to developing the understanding and competencies required by teachers for effective teaching-learning process. It provides opportunities of sharing experiences gained by teachers and develops in them an understanding of areas such as educational evaluation, school management etc. It is available in both English and Hindi medium.

It enables teachers to select and organize learning experiences according to the requirement of learners.

Rules And Regulations

Dress Code-

Vehicle Stand-

There is a Vehicle stand earmarked specifically within the college campus. Students will have to park their vehicles at proper vehicle stand only, otherwise a fine of Rs. 15 will be imposed.

Other Rules-

- There should be compulsory attendance of 75% of college working days of an academic session otherwise the student shall be restrained in the exam.
